### THINGS TO REMEMBER

Please send appropriate clothing to play outside. It is really starting to cool off, and we do go outside even in the winter. I highly recommend water resistant mittens especially in snow. Knit mittens are fine if they don't get wet but get cold very quickly when playing with snow. Shrinky gloves will not be warm enough as the weather gets cooler. I also want to discourage preschoolers from wearing crocs in the colder temperatures. Even though daytime temperatures are still relatively warm, when we go outside in the morning, it has been typically below zero the last couple of weeks. We do play outside for almost 30 minutes every day, so I would encourage your preschoolers to wear runners or warm boots, so they are not getting too cold.

Finally, I do try my best to remember to send out reminders for special events, but sometimes I am unable or, in all honesty, completely forget! Please mark down upcoming events on a calendar or on your phone so that special events such as Show and Tell or class parties are not missed. *DO NOT RELY* solely on a reminder from me because I do forget at least once every school year (I am the worst with Show and Tell)!
